Dear Parents,

The mastery of basic math facts will greatly increase your child's success in Mathematics in the coming years. I am sending home some addition and subtraction sheets to practice the facts. Please feel free to photocopy these for extra home practice. **Ideally, students should practice the facts on regular basis, just as they do their reading.** Some families have been using math games or apps at home, while some use flashcards (which can be purchased at dollar stores) or practice sheets at home. We will be regularly practicing how many addition and subtraction facts the children can complete correctly in one minute.
