CLASS PLACEMENTS

In early June, we will begin the thinking and planning process for student placement for the September 2021 school year. The placement of students in classes is a very thoughtful and complex process. During our placement discussions, consideration is given to many factors such as: a child's learning styles, behavioural and social needs, peer relationships, class size limits, class composition, grade balance - if it is a split class, male/female ratio, as well as the instructional needs in the class.

A reminder that we must consider all factors related to creating an educational sound placement for each child and while friendships and teacher requests are important and factors that are considered. We may not be able to accommodate the number of requests we receive when weighed against all of the educational factors of designing a classroom.

When drafting the classes for the following school year, the school team invests significant time to consider all of the above factors. We value the input of parents and require that parent's input is provided at the time the classes are drafted, rather than in the Fall.

Requests for changes to student placement in September can quickly create a domino effect and negate the original design of the classroom based on all of the students' needs, the social groupings and the balance in the classes. These changes then create a ripple effect in the design of several classes throughout the school. <u>Therefore, requests for changes to classes will not be made in</u> <u>September, unless there are exceptional circumstances.</u>
