Principal's Report:

Joanna:

- We had a great Remembrance Day assembly the kids were very well behaved and did an amazing job after not having a whole school assembly after almost 3 years. Thank you to the guests who came, and the staff that helped make this happen.
- Dec 5-14 we will be running a food drive to support the Salvation Army. Mrs. Mulder and Mrs. Murphy are taking their classes to Salvation Army Food bank to see how the whole operation works. Along with Mrs. Noer's class they will be taking the lead on the food drive. Our school will be collecting canned goods over those 2 weeks. Our school has been given pasta and pasta sauce as our special item, but we will take anything.
- Mrs. Piper and Mrs. Sanderson are coaching tripleball (volleyball) season starts next week!
- After collecting input from PAC and staff, the hat rule has been enforced again. Hats outside only, toques are ok in portables when it is cold
- Yesterday met with 22 grade 5s who will be primary playground monitors at lunch, 4-5 kids a day that will wear red vests and help on the primary side.
- Monday is assessment and evaluation day for elementary and middle schools, discussing the Jody Carrington presentation, teachers will work on report cards or assessments. CUPE members will also have modules and options for things to work on.
- Mountain West photographer feedback, retake time was way too short, it was a big rush to get them all done, the late date for the original photo day was not great but MountainWest provides us with the dates. There were some things that were not right like hair on the face or collars. They are not allowed to touch kids to fix things, but would welcome PAC parents there to help get the kids ready for a photo next year. Sticker system also doesn't work and won't be used again. Parents would like to see more consistent photos for the price they ask for.

DPAC Update:

RE: our playground and making it more accessible, Kate organized a meeting with the head of maintenance, and invited PAC's that have accessibility issues in their playgrounds.
