## DPAC Report -Kendy

DPAC is seeking feedback - do you feel like you are being heard? Do parents feel if their issues are being brought forward to DPAC. Survey will be posted soon for parents to access.
PAC Café - Oct 25 6pm. They will be discussing how does DPAC fit in? How do PACs run? What are the duties of a PAC?
DPAC wants to know what the barriers are for attending events? (lack of child care? Poor timing? Etc) What do PACS want from DPAC this year? What is or is not working. What type of events would parents find helpful (online safety, speakers on childhood eating disorders or anxiety etc).
RE: AC units for portables, principal needs to request from district to have them installed by spring. WE are looking for an alternate DPAC rep to attend meetings monthly on Zoom or in person.

## Treasurer Report:

General account - Includes revenue from bingo funds, seed money from investments, and fundraising. These funds vary from year to year. Also includes our annual PAC grant of $\$ 150$.

Gaming Account - we apply for a grant of $\$ 20$ per student (based on attendance in Sept 2022). PAC must spend funds by a certain time or lose it. There are regulations attached to spending it. Amanda did apply to this grant, and we got it! The PAC tries to make sure these funds benefit as many students as possible.

Motion by Kendy to accept the proposed budget for the gaming account (attached) after amending the field trip amount to $\$ 4500$. Seconded by Meghan. All in favor. Passed.

- School wide field trip grade 2-5 for Waterslides in June, any support.
- School wide field trip grade K-1 for Waterslides in June, any support.
- CSPOA field trip - Jan 10 for whole school to see Decendants. $\$ 9$ per ticket plus bussing at $\$ 880$.
- Presented by Erin, Grade 3 classes (and grade 3's in the split class) request for ceramic artist at a cost of $\$ 1743$. Ceramic Artist is Aleena Webber, disclosed during presentation of request.
- Hipwell a class set of Hush Ups for $\$ 249$.
- Cavanaugh - Unizoid Ninja Gym equipment $\$ 1318.46$ to be used for Indiana Jones and Ninja course.
- Blessin - looking to add planters behind the school. \$320 a planter looking to add at least 3 and allocating funds from $\$ 100-\$ 150$ annually to maintain the planters. Grade 3's will take on care and maintenance.
- Price - request for wagon to go to the school farm at a cost of \$124.
- Murphy/Hunt - \$80-\$100 supplies for initials project using tools, elastics, wood and other mediums.
- Halvorson/Dow - Grade 5’s Yukon Dan, comes to school every year \$770 (approved at 2022 budget meeting for 3 years)
- Letson - round trip school bus to go to Taves Pumpkin Patch on Oct 31, \$300.
- Grade 2's - Chilliwack Museum presentation \$300 (field trip experience to come to us).
- Colceriu - App Reading Theory (decoding and comprehension) Teach Your Monster to Read. $\$ 390$ for all tablets, $\$ 285.78$ for a class set, or $\$ 65$ for a few.
- Murphy/Mulder/Noer - Salvation Army field trip $\$ 110$ (bus only).
- Kindergarten Classes - Blue Heron field trip. Cost is \$760 (110 for bus)
- Anderson - Voice amplifier \$127, Light diffusers 2 packs for $\$ 151.22$ for classroom.
- Science World - $\$ 505$ (includes busing and $1 / 2$ lab fee for each class)
- Blessin - Grade 3's Want to bring in Raptor's Ridge at $\$ 580$ for 2 presentations.
- All Staff- Gym projector - $\$ 25,482$ is total cost. Asking for $\$ 10,000$.
