Here are some things for you to know as we head into week #35:

- 1) **Monday, April 29<sup>th</sup>**, is the last day to place your coffee and donut orders for the Grade 3 camp fundraiser. Orders will be available for pick-up after school on Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 2) Students will receive milk and apples on **Tuesday, April 30<sup>th</sup>** from the Agriculture in the Classroom program.
- 3) **Tuesday** is also when we will have a presentation in the afternoon thanks to a grant from the Art Starts program and the district. This year students will be treated to a show from Flo Warrior. This information is from his bio on the Art Starts site: Flo Warrior is a world renowned award winning instructor, multidisciplinary performance artist, and motivational speaker.
