



Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to inform you that beginning September 2024, the Chilliwack School District will provide the opportunity to pay for Elementary School consumable charges (school supplies) online using [StudentQuickPay.com](https://StudentQuickPay.com).

The ability for parents/guardians to log into their student's account(s) for all consumable charges will allow schools to focus more time on their students. We are committed to a seamless transition throughout the district for each student and are available to support parents/guardians through this change (see FAQ below).

### **Next Steps**

Charges will be posted to your student's account once they are placed into their class for the year and you will receive a notification email (to the email on file in MyEd at your child's school). Each school, as well as the District, has a SD33 QUICKPAY link on the Home page of their website – you will need to create an account if you haven't already, then will use that login ID.

You will receive a monthly statement of any outstanding charges which will remain on your student's account until paid.

### **Methods of payment:**

- Online @ [StudentQuickPay.com](https://StudentQuickPay.com) or on your school website "Links" menu "SD33 Pay Online"
- At the school with a credit card
- Call in to the school with your credit card information
- Cash (please avoid if possible) – please drop all cash off at your school's office rather than in the classroom(s)

### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

*Q: How do I change my email address?*

*A: Contact the school and they can change this in MyEd.*

*Q: Who do I call if I cannot pay online?*

*A: Call the school and they can process payment for you over the phone or can walk you through how to pay online.*

*Q: Do I have to pay for everything at once?*

*A: You can make partial payments; however, the District incurs fees each time a payment is made, so it is beneficial to pay multiple charges at once to limit these charges.*

*Q: What do I do if I cannot see my student(s)?*

*A: See the instructions on how to add a student (separate attachment) – if you have further issues, contact the school. When you log in, you should be able to see all of your children/students in the school district.*
