The cost of fast food has gone up and while she understands the cost is high for some of the options, we are charged a 2.9% + 30-cent flat fee per-transaction on MunchaLunch which is added to each food item. You don't see this as she incorporates those fees into the cost you see on MunchaLunch.

*Our Cross Country season is over for the fall, with the final run taking place last week at Twin Rinks on Thursday. Congratulations to all of the runners and our coaches for their time and dedication over the past month. We look forward to the Spring run, taking place May 1st, up at Cultus Lake Elementary!
