Field event practices will be at lunch time and most running events will take place during PE classes.

Wednesdays-Shot Put (Grass area in front of office)

Thursdays- High Jump (Gym)

Friday- 100m (Back Track) *the 100m will just be one day on May 9th *

Note: Athletes wanting to be considered for the District Meet are encouraged to attend all practices and mini meets. Athletes should try all events as you may be surprised at what you are good at. Each athlete is allowed up to three events at the District Track Meet, only three from each age group are chosen for the track events (1500m, 800m, 400m, 200m & 100m) and only two for each field event (High Jump, Long Jump, Ball Throw & Shot Put).

Mini Meets at Sardis Secondary Track

The mini meets are informal, after-school track meets for athletes to try events. They are opportunities for athletes to compete without the pressure to qualify. In other words, any number of students of the same grade may represent Sardis in any event. There are no ribbons awarded on these mini-meet days.

There are two mini-meets: **Wednesday**, **June 4**th **and Wednesday**, **June 11**th. These are held at the Sardis Track and Field Complex located behind Sardis Secondary School.

There is no bussing for the two mini-meets.
