Costumes need to be such that they can manage the regular activities of the day and use the washroom independently. Students can also wear black and orange if they prefer.

\*A note for the following week, Monday, November 3 is a non-instructional day for students as staff engage in assessment and evaluation activities.

\*Thanks to the parents who came out to the PAC budget meeting last week. There were many staff requests approved which will add value to our school and for our students. We appreciate your support! The next PAC meeting will be Wednesday, November 26 at 6:30.

\*A reminder if you are picking your child up early, please be sure to come inside to the office and sign them out. It's important that we know who is picking students up, to ensure they have permission in our MyEd system, and that we have a record of this in our logbook. We know it's easier to have them run out to the car when they see you pull up, but for their safety we need the adult to come in.
