Good afternoon, Sardis Families. It's nice to have had some rain and slightly cooler temperatures, but thankfully the Carnival night was just perfect for us last week! With only three weeks of school to go, it feels like the weeks are passing more and more quickly. Here are some things for you to know as we head into week #41 at Sardis Elementary:

*If you would like to order a hotdog hot lunch for your child to receive on Monday, June 8th, you have until 8:30 am Monday morning to order that. Some of you have a credit in MunchaLunch if you had ordered for the June 5th lunch that was cancelled, so you could put that towards the lunch on Monday, but you would still need to go in and place the order for your child.

*Students in Grades 3 -5 who have been trying out for Track and Field events will find out Monday if they have qualified to attend the District Track and Field meet happening on Thursday, June 18. There is another mini-meet at Sardis Secondary this Wednesday, June 10th at 3:30 with the following events running if your child would like to go to practice: 200m, 800m, relays, girls high jump, boys long jump, girls ball throw, and boys shot put. Parents are responsible for getting their child to the mini-meet as there is no school bus provided.
